With warmer weather arriving the final touches are being applied to the CE Pool. We are installing new lights at the top of the light poles around the pool. We've also ordered a new pool "robot" to keep the pool clean. The roof of the filter house is being extended and that area will get fencing. There are plans to put on a metal roof on the filter house.

And the finishing touch will be new epoxy paint on the interior of the pool itself. Thus we should have a fully restored swimming pool for use by campers this summer that should serve us for many years to come.

SILVER TOMAHAWK 90TH ANNIVERSARY



On June 2, 1934, the Order of the Arrow became an official part of the Boy Scouts of America. In the next year, the OA's popularity grew and Silver Tomahawk was chartered as the 80th Order of the Arrow Lodge on July 4, 1935.

This year marks the 90th Anniversary of that charter, and the Silver Tomahawk Honor Society is planning an event at Camp Eastman on August 9th to commemorate and celebrate 90 years of dedicated and cheerful service not only to Camp Eastman but more importantly to the development and maturation of thousands of scouters from Iowa, Missouri and Illinois.

ANOTHER 90TH ANNIVERSARY!

From Volume Two of Bill Ell's historical book series "The Story of Camping at Camp Eastman":

"In the summer of 1935 Mrs. Eastman caused to be built a stone lodge, which was to be known as "Eastman Lodge". At the completion of Eastman Lodge it was equipped by Mrs. Eastman with heavy oak tables and benches, dishes, refrigerator, copper pipe water system, a gas range and other items necessary for the operation.

This building, given in memory of her husband, Mr. E.P. Eastman, has been a wonderful asset to camp and has provided many fond memories for literally thousands of boys".

"Laying of the cornerstone of the new administration building at Camp Eastman, Southeast Iowa's Boy Scout Camp will be celebrated Sunday afternoon, May 26, 1935. An elaborate ceremony is being prepared and it is expected that all scouts and scouters in the council will participate.

The ceremony will be participated in by Cubs, Boy Scouts, and Sea Scouts. It is being prepared by J. L. Gafford, a member of the camp committee. The stone itself will be approximately 18 by 5 inches and is being prepared by the Burris Granite Company of Burlington. Into it will be sealed papers of interest to scouting and especially a history of scout camp and council which is being written by Tracy Garret.

Work on the building is progressing rapidly. The windows are being installed now and the stonework is about half completed". *Ref: Ft. Madison Democrat May 5,* 1935

The planned event was postponed and not completed until June 6, 1935. Be sure to stop by Eastman Lodge this spring, during Summer Camps or at the Silver Tomahawk Anniversary to see how CEDA has restored this beautiful and historic building!



JULY 4th, 2026 IS ALMOST HERE!



In 1961, the gathering of photos, memorabilia and other historical artifacts began in preparation for the setting of a time capsule at Camp Eastman to be opened on July 4th, 2000. The opening was done at an all day event, with many activity areas open, camp tours, and a program filled with appearances and reminiscing from multiple generations of Camp Eastman celebrities.

The planners of the year 2000 event decided it would be appropriate to install a new time capsule to be opened in 2026 to celebrate the 100th year of Scouting at Camp Eastman.



Encased in a vault at the base of the parade grounds flagpole, the new time capsule is awaiting the arrival of July 4th, 2026.
